ORDINANCE OF THE STATES

Made 2nd September, 1987
Coming into force 30th September, 1987

THE STATES WATER SUPPLY (RATES OF CHARGE)
(ALDERNEY) ORDINANCE, 1987

THE STATES, in pursuance of their Resolution of the 2nd day of September, 1987, and in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by sections 14 and 39A of the Alderney Water Supply Law, 1954, as amended (a), hereby order:-

Water according to rateable value for domestic purposes.

1. The annual rate referred to in section 14(1)(a)(i) of the Alderney Water Supply Law, 1954, as amended (hereinafter referred to as "the Law" for the supply of water to any property for domestic use shall be, from and including 30th September, 1987, 172 per centum of the rateable value according to the General Cadastre of the Island of the property supplied.

Water for baths.

2. The annual rate referred to in section 14(1)(a)(ii) of the Law for each ordinary bath fixed in any property shall be, from and including 30th September, 1987, £5.40.

Water by measure for domestic use.

3. The rate referred to in section 14(1)(b) of the Law for the supply of water by measure to any property for domestic use shall be, from and including 30th September, 1987, £2.05 per thousand gallons.

Water by measure for other than domestic purposes.

4. The rate referred to in section 14(2)(b) of the Law for the supply of water by measure for other than domestic purposes shall be, from and including 30th September, 1987, £2.05 per thousand gallons.

Water for glasshouses.

5. The charge referred to in section 14(3)(a) of the Law for the supply of water for other than domestic purposes shall in respect of glasshouses be calculated at the rate of 75p per hundred feet by thirty feet of glasshouse or proportionately thereof.

Repeal.

6. The States Water Supply (Rates of Charge) (Alderney) Ordinance, 1985, is hereby repealed.

Citation.

7. This Ordinance may be cited as the States Water Supply (Rates of Charge) (Alderney) Ordinance, 1987.

Commencement.

8. This Ordinance shall come into force on the 30th day of September, 1987.
