ORDINANCE OF THE STATES

Made 6th September, 1989
Coming into force30th September, 1989

THE STATES WATER SUPPLY (RATES OF CHARGE)
(ALDERNEY) ORDINANCE, 1989

THE STATES, in pursuance of their Resolution of the sixth day of September, 1989, and in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by Sections 14 and 39A of the Alderney Water Supply Law, 1954, as amended (a), hereby order:-

Water according to rateable value for domestic purposes

1. The annual rate referred to in Section 14(1)(a)(i) of the Alderney Water Supply Law, 1954, as amended (hereinafter referred to as "the Law") for the supply of water to any property for domestic use shall be, from and including 30th September, 1989, £1.96 per centum of the rateable value according to the General Cadastre of the Island of the property supplied.

Water for baths

2. The annual rate referred to in Section 14(a)(ii) of the Law for each ordinary bath fixed in any property shall be, from and including 30th September, 1989, £6.20.

Water by measure for domestic use

3. The rate referred to in Section 14(1)(b) of the Law for the supply of water by measure to any property for domestic use shall be, from and including 30th September, 1989:

- (a) if the water is supplied by the gallon, £2.36 per thousand gallons;
- (b) if the water is supplied by the cubic metre, £0.52 per cubic metre.

Water by measure for other than domestic purposes

4. The rate referred to in Section 14(2)(b) of the Law for the supply of water by measure for other than domestic purposes shall be, from and including 30th September, 1989:

- (a) if the water is supplied by the gallon, £2.36 per thousand gallons;
- (b) if the water is supplied by the cubic metre, £0.52 per cubic metre.

Repeal

5. The States Water Supply (Rates of Charge) (Alderney) Ordinance, 1987 is hereby repealed.

Citation

6. This Ordinance may be cited as the States Water Supply (Rates of Charge) (Alderney) Ordinance, 1989.

Commencement

7. This Ordinance shall come into force on the 30th day of September, 1989.
