THE STATES WATER SUPPLY (RATES OF CHARGE) (ALDERNEY) ORDINANCE, 2002

THE STATES OF ALDERNEY, in pursuance of their Resolution of the 23rd day of October, 2002, and in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by sections 14 and 39A of the Alderney Water Supply Law, 1954, as amended¹, hereby order:—

1. The annual charge for the supply of water to any property, from and including the 26th December, 2002, shall be (except where the property is supplied by measure) the sum of the following-

- (a) £236 per centum of the rateable value according to the General Cadastre of the Island of the property supplied as at the date of the account; and
 - (b) such additional charges in relation to the non-metered use of water as are set out in the Schedule to this Ordinance and as may be applicable in respect of the property supplied.

Water supplied according to rateable value.
2. (1) The charge for the water to any property by measure for domestic use, from and including the 26th December 2002 shall be the following-

Water supplied by measure for domestic use.

- (a) if water is supplied by the gallon, £3.77 per thousand gallons; or
- (b) if the water is supplied by the cubic meter, £0.83 per cubic metre.

- (2) Notwithstanding the provisions of subsection (1), the States General Services Committee may determine a minimum quarterly charge for the supply of water to any property for domestic use by measure:

Provided always that such minimum quarterly charge shall not exceed one quarter of the amount which would be payable annually in respect of the property supplied under and by virtue of section 1(a) and (b).

Water supplied by measure for other than domestic use.

- 3. The charge for the supply of water to any property by measure for any use other than domestic use, from and including the 26th December 2002, shall be the sum of the following-
 - (a) a standing quarterly charge of £25, and
 - (b) if the water is supplied-
 - (i) by the gallon, £3.77 per thousand gallons; or
 - (ii) by the cubic meter, £0.83 per cubic metre.

Repeal.

- 4. The States Water Supply (Rates of Charge) (Alderney) Ordinance, 1997 and the States Water Supply (Rates of Charge) (Amendment) (Alderney) Ordinance, 1998 are hereby repealed.

Citation.

- 5. This Ordinance may be cited as the States Water Supply (Rates of Charge) (Alderney) Ordinance, 2002.

Commencement.

- 6. This Ordinance shall come into force on the 26th December, 2002.

SCHEDULE

ADDITIONAL CHARGES IN RELATION TO THE NON-METERED USE OF WATER

1. Supply to properties with jacuzzi, spa pool or similar installation.	£15.00 per quarter.
2. Supply to cafes, chip shops, licensed premises and take-away food outlets.	£21.00 per quarter.
3. Charge in respect of use of garden hoses [1/2 inch hoses only may be used].	£6.75 per quarter.
4. Supply to guesthouses, boarding houses or hotels.	£10.50 per head of approved accommodation per year, payable with September quarter bill.
5. Supply to hairdressers and dentist.	£21.00 per quarter.
6. Supply to greenhouses of a floor area greater than 250 ft.	£21.00 per quarter.
7. Charge in respect of building in the course of erection.	£9.60 per 100 square feet gross floor area.
8. Charge in respect of wall, etc, in the course of erection payable only if no payment is due in respect of the wall, etc under item 7).	£9.60 per 400 square foot surface area (external face only).
9. Charge in respect of service connection.	£110.00 per minimum charge per connection.
10. Minimum charge per supply.	£21.00 per quarter.
11. Supply to lock-up business premises.	At the General Services Committee's discretion, may be charged on 50% of the rateable value.
