The Stray Dogs (Amendment) Ordinance, 1952.

THE STATES, on the representations of the Island Police Committee, hereby order:—

1. Section one of the Stray Dogs Ordinance, 1941 (hereinafter referred to as “the principal Ordinance”) is hereby amended as follows—

- (a) in subsection (3) of the said section the word “seven” is hereby repealed and the word “four” is hereby substituted therefor;
- (b) in subsection (5) of the said section the word “seven”, where that word occurs, is hereby repealed and the word “four” is hereby substituted therefor.

2. This Ordinance and the principal Ordinance may be cited together as the Stray Dogs Ordinances, 1941 and 1952.
