## **The Shellfish (Import) (Amendment) Ordinance, 1958**

THE STATES LEGISLATION COMMITTEE, in pursuance of the powers conferred upon them by Article sixty-six of the Reform (Guernsey) Law, 1948, and on the representations of the States Board of Health, hereby order:—

1. The Shellfish (Import) Ordinance, 1953 (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Ordinance") is hereby amended as follows—

- (a) section two thereof is hereby repealed;
- (b) section three thereof is hereby repealed and the following section substituted therefor—

“3. Any person who contravenes or attempts to contravene the provisions of section one of this Ordinance shall be guilty of an offence and liable, on conviction, to a fine not exceeding ten pounds and the Court may in addition thereto order the destruction of the shellfish to which the conviction relates at the expense of the convicted person.”;

(c) in section four thereof the definition of the expression “importer” is hereby deleted.

2. This Ordinance and the principal Ordinance may be cited together as the Shellfish (Import) Ordinances, 1953 and 1958.

3. This Ordinance shall come into force on the twenty-fourth day of January, nineteen hundred and fifty-eight.
