The Slaughter of Livestock (Amendment) Ordinance, 1996

THE STATES, in pursuance of their resolution of 30th May 1996^a, and in exercise of the powers conferred by Article 1 of the Ordonnance relative aux Publics, aux Abattoirs et à la vente de la Viande of 20th April, 1918^b and now in them^c, hereby order: –

Amendments to Slaughter of Animals Ordinance.

1. In the Slaughter of Animals (Use of Humane Killers) Ordinance, 1948^d ("the 1948 Ordinance") –

- (a) in the definition of "the Board" in section 1, for "Board of Administration" substitute "Agricultural and Milk Marketing Board",¹
- (b) in the definition of "scheduled animal" in section 1, delete "and above the age",
- (c) in section 3, immediately after "the States Veterinary Officer" insert ", or otherwise than in such manner as may be approved by the States Veterinary Officer,"
- (d) in section 7, for "the Slaughter of Livestock Ordinance

1946, or any enactment amending or replacing that Ordinance" substitute "any other enactment for the being in force",

(e) for the Schedule substitute –

Transitional provisions.

2. (1) Any licence issued by the States [Home Department] before August, 1996 under the 1948 Ordinance shall be deemed on and after 1st August, 1996 to have been issued by the States Agricultural and Milk Marketing Board, on the date on which it was in fact issued, as if this Ordinance had been in force on date.

(2) On 1st August, 1996 the register maintained by the States [Home Department] in accordance with section 4 of the 1948 Ordinance shall be

delivered to the States Agricultural and Milk Marketing Board and that Board shall thereafter be deemed to have compiled and maintained that register.

NOTES

In section 2, the words in square brackets were substituted by the of Government (Transfer of Functions) (Guernsey) Ordinance, 2003, 2, Schedule 1, paragraph 3(a), with effect from 6th May, 2004.

The functions, rights and liabilities of the Board of Administration and of its President arising under or by virtue of this Ordinance were transferred to and vested in, respectively, the Home Department and its Minister by the Machinery of Government (Transfer of Functions) (Guernsey) Ordinance, 2003, section 1, Schedule 1, paragraph 3(a), with effect from 6th May, 2004, subject to the savings and transitional provisions in section 4 of the 2003 Ordinance.

The States Agricultural and Milk Marketing Board, referred to in section 2, has since been replaced by the States Agriculture and Countryside Board, the reference to which has since been substituted by a reference to the Commerce and Employment Department by the Machinery of Government (Transfer of Functions) (Guernsey) Ordinance, 2003, section 2, Schedule 1, paragraph 2, with effect from 6th May, 2004.

The functions, rights and liabilities of the Agriculture and Countryside Board and of its President arising under or by virtue of this Ordinance were transferred to and vested in, respectively, the Commerce and Employment Department and its Minister by the Machinery of Government (Transfer of Functions) (Guernsey) Ordinance, 2003, section 1, Schedule 1, paragraph 2, with effect from 6th May, 2004, subject to the savings and transitional provisions in section 4 of the 2003 Ordinance.
