**The Surf-Riding (Longboards) (Compulsory  
Third-Party Insurance) (Guernsey) Law,  
1969 (Commencement) Ordinance, 1970**

THE STATES, in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section four of the Surf-Riding (Longboards) (Compulsory Third-Party Insurance) (Guernsey) Law, 1969(a), and section three of the Surf-Riding (Longboards) (Compulsory Third-Party Insurance) (Amendment) (Guernsey) Law, 1969(b), hereby order:—

1. The Surf-Riding (Longboards) (Compulsory Third-Party Insurance) (Guernsey) Law, 1969, and the Surf-Riding (Longboards) (Compulsory Third-Party Insurance) (Amendment) (Guernsey) Law, 1969, shall come into force on the first day of May, nineteen hundred and seventy.
