**The Swine Fever (Amendment)
Ordinance, 1964**

THE STATES, in pursuance of their Resolution of the twenty-sixth day of June, nineteen hundred and sixty-three, hereby order:—

1. The Swine Fever Ordinance, 1955, as amended (*a*), is hereby further amended, as follows:—

- (*a*) the word “and” at the end of paragraph (*g*) of subsection (1) of section five thereof is hereby repealed;
- (*b*) the full stop at the end of paragraph (*h*) of subsection (1) of section five thereof is hereby deleted and a semi-colon is hereby substituted therefor and immediately thereafter there are hereby inserted the following two additional paragraphs—

“(1) no swine on an Infected Place shall be slaughtered and dressed for human consumption; and

- (j) the owner, or person in charge, of swine on an Infected Place shall keep, or cause to be kept, at or near every exit to the Infected Place a receptacle of a type, and containing disinfectant, approved from time to time by the States Veterinary Officer and such disinfectant shall be changed or renewed by the said owner or person from time to time as that Officer may direct.”;
- (c) immediately after section six thereof there is hereby inserted the following additional section numbered “6A”—
- “6A. The Board may by order prohibit the movement of swine into any premises or any part thereof, not being premises which have been declared an Infected Place in pursuance of the provisions of subsection (1) of section five of this Ordinance, on which there is, or has been, swine exposed to infection by swine fever.”;
- (d) in subsection (1) of section eight thereof the words “for the purposes of diagnosis” are hereby repealed.

2. This Ordinance may be cited as the Swine Fever (Amendment) Ordinance, 1964, and this Ordinance and the Swine Fever Ordinances, 1955 and 1959, may be cited together as the Swine Fever Ordinances, 1955 to 1964.
