**The Swine Fever and other Swine
Diseases (Amendment) Ordinance, 1975**

THE STATES, in pursuance of their Resolutions of the twelfth day of December, nineteen hundred and seventy-three and the twenty-fifth day of September, nineteen hundred and seventy-four, hereby order:—

1. The Swine Fever Ordinance, 1955, as amended (a), (hereinafter referred to as “the principal Ordinance”), is hereby further amended as follows:—

- (a) in that Ordinance the expression “the Board”, wherever that expression occurs therein, is repealed and the expression “the Committee” is substituted therefor;
- (b) in section one thereof the definition of the expression “Board” is repealed and the following definition is substituted therefor—

“ “the Committee” means the States Committee for Agriculture;”;

- (c) subsection (1) of section twelve thereof is repealed and the following subsection is substituted therefor—

“ (1) The compensation payable under and in accordance with the provisions of the last preceding section shall be—

- (a) in the case of a breeding sow or boar, seventy-five pounds or its market value immediately before slaughter, whichever is the less;
- (b) in the case of any other swine weighing under one hundred pounds, five pounds for the first month of age of the swine with an additional four pounds for each subsequent month of age thereof or its market value immediately before slaughter, whichever is the less;
- (c) in the case of any other swine weighing one hundred pounds or over, its value as meat.”

- (d) immediately after section twenty-four thereof there is inserted the following additional section numbered “25”—

“Application to other diseases. 25. The provisions of this Ordinance shall apply to the diseases specified in the Schedule to this Ordinance as they apply to Swine Fever and such provisions shall have effect as if references therein to Swine Fever included references to those diseases.”;

- (e) section twenty-five thereof is renumbered as section "26";
- (f) immediately after section twenty-six thereof there is inserted the Schedule set out in the Schedule to this Ordinance.
2. In the case of a swine slaughtered under the provisions of the principal Ordinance before the coming into force of this Ordinance and in respect of which compensation in accordance with the provisions of that Ordinance has not been paid at the date of the coming into force of this Ordinance, compensation shall be payable in respect of that swine as if this Ordinance had not been passed. Compensation in respect of swine slaughtered before the coming into force of this Ordinance.
3. The Atrophic Rhinitis Ordinance, 1954(b), and the Atrophic Rhinitis (Compensation Provisions) Ordinance, 1954(c), are hereby repealed. Repeals.
4. This Ordinance shall be construed as one with the principal Ordinance. Construction.
5. This Ordinance shall apply to the Islands of Guernsey, Herm and Jethou. Extent
6. This Ordinance may be cited as the Swine Fever and other Swine Diseases (Amendment) Ordinance, 1975. Citation.
7. This Ordinance and the Swine Fever Ordinances, 1955 to 1964, may be cited together as the Swine Diseases Ordinances, 1955 to 1975. Collective title.
