

The Uniform Scale of Fines (Sark) (Amendment) Ordinance, 2004

THE CHIEF PLEAS OF SARK, in exercise of the powers conferred on them by section 1(3) of the Uniform Scale of Fines (Sark) Law, 1989¹, and in pursuance of their Resolution of the 21st January 2004, hereby order:-

Amendment to the uniform scale of fines.

1. The table in section 1(2) of the Uniform Scale of Fines (Sark) Law, 1989² is deleted and the following substituted:

TABLE

<u>Level on the Scale</u>	<u>Amount of Fine</u>
1	£200
2	£500
3	£1000
4	£2500
5	£5000

Transitional provisions.

2. (1) This Ordinance shall only have effect in relation to penalties imposed for offences committed after the date it comes into force.

(2) The maximum penalty to which an offender is liable for an offence committed before the date this Ordinance comes into force shall, in any proceedings after that date, be determined as if this Ordinance was not in force.

Repeal.

3. The Uniform Scale of Fines (Sark) (Amendment) Ordinance, 1992 is repealed.

Citation.

4. This Ordinance may be cited as the Uniform Scale of Fines (Sark) (Amendment) Ordinance, 2004.
