### **The Vessels and Speedboats (Amount of Compulsory Third-Party Insurance) Ordinance, 1971**

THE STATES, in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by subsection (5) of section one of the Vessels and Speedboats (Compulsory Third-Party Insurance, Mooring Charges and Removal of Boats) (Guernsey) Law, 1968, as amended<sup>(a)</sup>, and in pursuance of their Resolution of the thirty-first day of March, nineteen hundred and seventy-one, hereby order:—

1. The amounts specified in paragraphs (a), (b) and (c) respectively of subsection (2) of section one of the Vessels and Speedboats (Compulsory Third-Party Insurance, Mooring Charges and Removal of Boats) (Guernsey) Law, 1968, as amended, shall in each such paragraph be varied to fifteen thousand pounds. Amount of insurance.
