**The Vessels and Speedboats (Compulsory
Third-Party Insurance, Mooring Charges
and Removal of Boats) (Guernsey) Laws,
1968 and 1969 (Commencement)
Ordinance, 1970**

THE STATES, in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section six of the Vessels and Speedboats (Compulsory Third-party Insurance, Mooring Charges and Removal of Boats) (Guernsey) Law, 1968(a), and section three of the Vessels and Speedboats (Compulsory Third-Party Insurance, Mooring Charges and Removal of Boats) (Amendment) (Guernsey) Law, 1969(b), hereby order:—

1. The Vessels and Speedboats (Compulsory Third-party Insurance, Mooring Charges and Removal of Boats) (Guernsey) Law, 1968, and the Vessels and Speedboats (Compulsory Third-Party Insurance, Mooring Charges and Removal of Boats) (Amendment) (Guernsey) Law, 1969, shall come into force on the twenty-sixth day of February, nineteen hundred and seventy. Commencement of Laws of 1968 and 1969.

2. This Ordinance may be cited as the Vessels and Speedboats (Compulsory Third-Party Insurance, Mooring Charges and Removal of Boats) (Guernsey) Laws, 1968 and 1969 (Commencement) Ordinance, 1970. Citation.
