**The Vessels and Speedboats (Variation of Insurance  
Cover) Ordinance, 1994**

THE STATES, on the representations of the Board of Administration, and in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section 1(6) of the Vessels and Speedboats (Compulsory Third-Party Insurance, Mooring Charges and Removal of Boats) (Guernsey) Law, 1972, as amended(a), hereby order:-

**Increase in levels of compulsory insurance.**

1. In section 1 of the Vessels and Speedboats (Compulsory Third-Party Insurance, Mooring Charges and Removal of Boats) (Guernsey) Law, 1972, as amended-

- (a) in subsection (1)(c), for "one hundred thousand pounds" substitute "£500,000";
- (b) in subsection (1)(d), for "one hundred thousand pounds" substitute "£500,000" and for "five hundred thousand pounds" substitute "£2,000,000";
- (c) in subsections (2) and (3), for "one hundred thousand pounds" substitute "£500,000".

**Repeal.**

2. The Vessels and Speedboats (Compulsory Third-Party Insurance) (Variation of Cover) (Guernsey) Ordinance, 1981(b) is repealed.

**Citation.**

3. This Ordinance may be cited as the Vessels and Speedboats (Variation of Insurance Cover) Ordinance, 1994.

**Commencement.**

4. This Ordinance shall come into force on the 1st October, 1994.
