### **The Water Byelaws (Restrictions) Ordinance, 1973**

WHEREAS the States Water Board on the twenty-fourth day of August, nineteen hundred and seventy-three, made the Byelaws set out in the Schedule to this Ordinance:

NOW THEREFORE THE STATES LEGISLATION COMMITTEE, in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by paragraph (3) of Article sixty-six of the Reform (Guernsey) Law, 1948(a), and in pursuance of the powers now vested in them by Article thirty of the Law entitled "Loi ayant rapport à la Fourniture d'Eau par les Etats de cette Ile aux habitants de la dite Ile" registered on the seventh day of May, nineteen hundred and twenty-seven (b), hereby order:—

1. The Byelaws set out in the Schedule to this Ordinance are hereby sanctioned. **Byelaws sanctioned.**

- Offences.** 2. Any person who contravenes or fails to comply with the provisions of Byelaw 1 of the Byelaws set out in the Schedule to this Ordinance shall be guilty of an offence and liable, on conviction, to a fine not exceeding twenty-five pounds.
- Repeal.** 3. The Ordinance entitled “Ordonnance approuvant un Règlement fait par le Conseil des Eaux par rapport à la Conservation d’Eau” of the seventh day of May, nineteen hundred and thirty-eight, is hereby repealed.
- Citation.** 4. This Ordinance may be cited as the Water Byelaws (Restrictions) Ordinance, 1973.

#### SCHEDULE

*Byelaws made by the States Water Board under the provisions of Article thirty of the Law entitled “Loi ayant rapport à la Fourniture d’Eau par les Etats de cette Ile aux habitants de la dite Ile” registered on the seventh day of May, nineteen hundred and twenty-seven.*

1. A person shall not, during such period as may be specified in a notice in that behalf given by the States Water Board (hereinafter referred to as “the Board”) and signed by the President or Vice-President thereof or, if no period is so specified until the date on which any such first mentioned notice is revoked by the Board by a further notice given and signed as aforesaid, use water supplied by the Board in pursuance of the provisions of the Law entitled “Loi ayant rapport à la Fourniture d’Eau par les Etats de cette Ile aux habitants de la dite Ile” registered on the seventh day of May, nineteen hundred and twenty-seven, for all or such of the following purposes as may be specified in any such notice:—

- (a) for the purposes of—
  - (i) cleaning any vehicle, or
  - (ii) cleaning any window or shopfront, or
  - (iii) watering any garden or lawn;
 or for such purposes otherwise than by such means as may be specified in any such notice;
- (b) for any purpose relating to the enjoyment of a dwelling house as such by the use of a hose, sprinkler or other similar apparatus;
- (c) for the purposes of filling or replenishing any swimming pool.

2. Any notice given by the Board under the provisions of the last preceding Byelaw shall be published on at least two occasions in "La Gazette Officielle" during the seven days immediately preceding the date on which such notice comes into force.

3. In these Byelaws the expression "dwelling house" means any premises, or any part of any premises, wholly or principally used or usable for the purposes of human habitation and includes any part of such a dwelling.

4. These Byelaws may be cited as the Water (Restrictions) Byelaws, 1973.
