**The Watercourses (No. 2) Ordinance, 1961**

THE STATES, under and by virtue of the powers now vested in them under section fifteen of the Law entitled "Loi relative aux Douits" registered on the Records of this Island on the fourteenth day of November, nineteen hundred and thirty-six, and in pursuance of their Resolution of the eighth day of November, nineteen hundred and sixty-one, hereby order:—

1. The watercourses draining to and discharging at Rocquaine Bay and which are marked in blue on a map which for the purposes of identification has been signed by the Bailiff on the twentieth day of November, nineteen hundred and sixty-one, and lodged at the Greffe, and all tributaries of any of the said watercourses and all canals flowing into any of the said watercourses or tributaries, whether or not such tributaries or canals are marked on the said

map, shall be subject to the application of the provisions of the Law entitled "Loi relative aux Douits" registered on the Records of this Island on the fourteenth day of November, nineteen hundred and thirty-six.

**Repeal.** 2. Section two of the Watercourses Ordinance, 1961, is hereby repealed.

**Citation and collective title.** 3. This Ordinance may be cited as the Watercourses (No. 2) Ordinance, 1961, and this Ordinance, the Watercourses Ordinance, 1961, and the Watercourses Ordinances, 1937 and 1957, may be cited together as the Watercourses Ordinances, 1937 to 1961.
