The Watercourses Ordinance, 1957

THE STATES, under and by virtue of the powers now vested in them under section fifteen of the Law entitled "Loi relative aux Douits" registered on the Records of this Island on the fourteenth day of November, nineteen hundred and thirty-six, and in pursuance of their Resolution of the thirty-first day of July, nineteen hundred and fifty-seven, hereby order:—

1. The watercourses draining to and discharging at La Grande Mare, La Biloterie and La Maladrie respectively, and which are marked in blue on a map which for the purposes of identification has been signed by the Bailiff on the eleventh day of December, nineteen hundred and fifty-seven, and lodged at the Greffe, and all tributaries of any of the said watercourses and all canals flowing into any of the said watercourses or tributaries, whether or not such tributaries and canals are marked on the said map,

shall be subject to the application of the provisions of the Law entitled "Loi relative aux Douits" registered on the Records of this Island on the fourteenth day of November, nineteen hundred and thirty-six.

2. This Ordinance and the Ordinance entitled "Ordonnance relative aux Douits" of the seventeenth day of April, nineteen hundred and thirty-seven, may be cited together as the Watercourses Ordinances, 1937 and 1957.
