The Watercourses Ordinance, 1972

THE STATES, in pursuance of their Resolution of the twenty-eighth day of September, nineteen hundred and seventy-two, and in exercise of the powers now vested in them by section fifteen of the Law entitled "Loi relative aux Douits" registered on the fourteenth day of November, nineteen hundred and thirty-six(a), and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, hereby order:—

1. The watercourses—

- (a) draining to and discharging at La Lague which are marked in blue on a map which for the purposes of identification has been signed by the Bailiff on the twenty-ninth day of November, nineteen hundred and seventy-two, and lodged at the Greffe; and
- (b) draining to and discharging into the public sewer at La Charroterie which are marked in red on a map which for the purposes

of identification has been signed by the Bailiff on the twenty-ninth day of November, nineteen hundred and seventy-two, and lodged at the Greffe;

and all tributaries of any of the said watercourses and all canals flowing into any of the said watercourses or tributaries, whether or not such tributaries or canals are marked on the said maps, shall be subject to the application of the provisions of the Law entitled "Loi relative aux Douits" registered on the fourteenth day of November, nineteen hundred and thirty-six.

Citation. 2. This Ordinance may be cited as the Watercourses Ordinance, 1972.

Collective title. 3. This Ordinance and the Watercourses Ordinances, 1937 to 1970(b), may be cited together as the Watercourses Ordinances, 1937 to 1972.
