## Ordinance of the States **XXXIV** **1980**

Made ... .. 11th December, 1980.  
Came into Operation ... 11th December, 1980.

### **The Watercourses Ordinance, 1980**

THE STATES, in pursuance of their Resolution of the twenty-fourth day of September, nineteen hundred and eighty, and in exercise of the powers now vested in them by section fifteen of the Law entitled "Loi relative aux Douits" registered on the fourteenth day of November, nineteen hundred and thirty-six<sup>(a)</sup>, and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, hereby order:—

1. The watercourses draining to and discharging at Perelle Bay which are marked in blue on a map which for the purposes of identification has been signed by the Bailiff on the eleventh day of December, nineteen hundred and eighty, and lodged at the Greffe, and all tributaries of any of the said watercourses and all canals flowing into any of the said watercourses or tributaries, whether or not such tributaries or canals are marked on the said map, shall be subject to the application of the provisions of the Law entitled "Loi relative aux Douits" registered on the fourteenth day of November, nineteen hundred and thirty-six.

2. The Watercourses Ordinance, 1957(b), is hereby amended as follows:—

(a) in section one thereof the words “The watercourses draining to and discharging at La Grande Mare” are repealed and the words “Subject to the provisions of the next succeeding section, the watercourses draining to and discharging at La Grande Mare” are substituted therefor;

(b) immediately after section one thereof there is inserted the following additional section numbered “1A”—

“Exception. 1A. The provisions of the last preceding section shall not apply to that part of the watercourses draining to and discharging at La Grande Mare which is marked in red on a map which for the purposes of identification has been signed by the Bailiff on the eleventh day of December, nineteen hundred and eighty, and lodged at the Greffe.”.

3. This Ordinance may be cited as the Watercourses Ordinance, 1980.
