**The Waterworks Byelaws (Amendment)  
Ordinance, 1956.**

(No. XIX—  
1956)

WHEREAS the States Water Board on the sixth day of April, nineteen hundred and fifty-six, in pursuance of Article thirty of the Law entitled “Loi ayant rapport à la Fourniture d’Eau par les Etats de cette Ile aux Habitants de la dite Ile” registered on the 7th day of May, 1927, made the Byelaws set out in the Schedule to this Ordinance:

THE STATES, on the representations of the States Water Board and in pursuance of the powers now vested in them by the said Article thirty, hereby order:—

1. The Byelaws made by the States Water Board on the sixth day of April, nineteen hundred and fifty-six, and set out in the Schedule to this Ordinance are hereby sanctioned. Byelaws sanctioned.

2. This Ordinance may be cited as the Waterworks Byelaws (Amendment) Ordinance, 1956, and this Ordinance and the Waterworks Byelaws Ordinances, 1938 to 1954, may be cited together as the Waterworks Byelaws Ordinances, 1938 to 1956. Citation.

## SCHEDULE

*Byelaws made by the States Water Board under Article thirty of the Law entitled "Loi ayant rapport à la Fourniture d'Eau par les Etats de cette Ile aux Habitants de la dite Ile" registered on the 7th day of May, 1927.*

Byelaw 3.

1. Paragraph (a) of Byelaw 3 of the Byelaws set out in the Schedule to the Waterworks Byelaws Ordinance, 1948 (which Byelaws are hereinafter referred to as "the principal Byelaws") is hereby amended as follows, that is to say—

- (a) the comma after the word "misuse" is hereby deleted and there is hereby substituted therefor the word "or";
- (b) the comma and words ", or contamination" are hereby repealed; and
- (c) after the word "pipes" there are hereby inserted a comma and the words ", or which may, or is so arranged or connected that it may, tend to cause contamination of water".

Byelaw 4.

2. Byelaw 4 of the principal Byelaws is hereby amended as follows, that is to say—

- (a) the comma after the word "misuse" is hereby deleted and there is hereby substituted therefor the word "or";
- (b) the words "or contamination" are hereby repealed; and
- (c) after the word "pipes" there are hereby inserted a comma and the words ", or may, or is so arranged or connected that it may, tend to cause contamination of water supplied by the Board".

Byelaw 29.

3. Byelaw 29 of the principal Byelaws is hereby amended as follows, that is to say—

- (a) in paragraph (1) the words "or cistern" are hereby repealed and there are hereby sub-

stituted therefor the words "or receptacle";  
and

- (b) there is hereby inserted at the end thereof the following paragraph (3):—

"(3) In this Byelaw the expression "service pipe" means so much of any pipe of any description, including a hose pipe, containing water supplied from a main of the Board as is subject to water pressure from that main or would be so subject but for the closing of some tap."
