SCHEDULE Section one

" FIRST SCHEDULE Section one

Wharfage on goods imported

Class or description of goods imported	Rate of wharfage
1. Goods of a class or description not chargeable with a special duty under any of the succeeding paragraphs of this Schedule.	60p per ton gross weight.
2. Gravel, sand and shingle.	4p per ton gross weight.
3. Anthracite; coal, including manufactured fuels of coal; coke and semi-coke of coal; limestone; and lime.	19p per ton gross weight.
4. Softwoods for box-making.	37p per ton gross weight.
5. Hydrocarbon oils imported in bulk in quantities of not less than twenty tons.	56p per two hundred and ten gallons.
6. Live animals.	Nil.
7. Vehicles:—	
(a) motor cars, motor lorries, commercial vans, special purpose vehicles and omnibuses;	£7.50 each.
(b) chassis of motor cars, motor lorries, commercial vans, special purpose vehicles and omnibuses.	£3.75 each.
