**The “Terres mises à l'Amende”
(Amendment) Ordinance, 1969**

THE STATES, in pursuance of their Resolution of the thirtieth day of October, nineteen hundred and sixty-nine, hereby order:—

1. In the Ordinance relating to “Terres mises à l'Amende” of the sixteenth day of January, seven-
teen hundred and eighty-six^(a), the figures and word “60 sols” are hereby repealed and the words “d'une somme n'excédant pas vingt-cinq livres sterling” are hereby substituted therefor. Amendment to Ordinance of 1786.

2. In the Ordinance entitled “Ordonnance par rapport aux Terres mises à l'Amende” of the twenty-ninth day of October, nineteen hundred and thirty-eight^(b), the words, symbol and figure “de £3 tournois” are hereby repealed and the words “n'excédant” Amendment to Ordinance of 1938.
