ORDER IN COUNCIL



IN THE ROYAL COURT OF THE ISLAND OF GUERNSEY

The 30th day of September, 1991 before Sir Charles Frossard, Kt., Bailiff; present:—Harry Wilson Bisson, Herbert Nicolle Machon, Geoffrey Ernest Le Page, Stanley Walter John Jehan, Raymond Arthur Heaume, Esquires, Mrs. Dorothy Winifred Le Pelley, Leonard Arthur Moss, John Edward Morris, Charles Anthony Spensley, Kenneth John Rowe, Lawrence Oscar Ozanne and John Richard Rowe Henry, Esquires, Jurats.

The Bailiff having this day placed before the Court an Order of Her Majesty in Council dated the 26th June, 1991, approving and ratifying a *Projet de Loi* entitled “The Attendance and Invalid Care Allowances (Amendment) (Guernsey) Law, 1991”, THE COURT, after the reading of the said Order and after having heard Her Majesty’s Procureur thereon, ordered:—

1. That the said Order in Council be registered on the records of this Island and
2. That an extract of this present act, together with a copy of the said Order in Council, be sent by Her Majesty’s Greffier to the Clerk of the Court of Alderney for registration on the records of that Island of which Order in Council the tenor followeth:—

At the Court at Buckingham Palace

The 26th day of June 1991

PRESENT,

The Queen's Most Excellent Majesty in Council

WHEREAS there was this day read at the Board a Report from the Right Honourable the Lords of the Committee of Council for the affairs of Guernsey and Jersey dated the 14th day of June 1991 in the words following, viz.:—

“YOUR MAJESTY having been pleased, by Your General Order of Reference of the 22nd day of February 1952, to refer unto this Committee the humble petition of the States of the Island of Guernsey setting forth:—

‘1. That, in pursuance of their Resolution of the 28th day of June 1990 the States of Deliberation at a meeting held on the 28th day of June 1990 approved a Bill or “Projet de Loi” entitled “The Attendance and Invalid Care Allowances (Amendment) (Guernsey) Law, 1991”, and requested the Bailiff to present a most humble Petition to Your Majesty in Council praying for Your Royal Sanction thereto. 2. That the said Bill or “Projet de Loi” is as set forth in the Schedule hereunto annexed. And most humbly praying that Your Majesty might be graciously pleased to grant Your Royal Sanction to the Bill or “Projet de Loi” of the States of Guernsey entitled “The Attendance and Invalid Care Allowances (Amendment) (Guernsey) Law, 1991”, and to order that the same shall have force of law in the Islands of Guernsey, Alderney, Herm and Jethou.’

“THE LORDS OF THE COMMITTEE, in obedience to Your Majesty’s said Order of Reference, have taken the said Petition and the said Projet de Loi into consideration and do this day

agree humbly to report, as their opinion, to Your Majesty, that it may be advisable for Your Majesty to comply with the prayer of the said petition and to approve of and ratify the said Projet de Loi.”

HER MAJESTY having taken the said Report into consideration is pleased, by and with the advice of Her Privy Council, to approve of and ratify the said Projet de Loi, and to order, and it is hereby ordered, that the same shall have the force of Law within the Islands of Guernsey, Alderney, Herm and Jethou.

AND HER MAJESTY doth hereby further direct that this Order, and the said Projet de Loi (a copy whereof is hereunto annexed), be entered upon the Register of the Island of Guernsey and observed accordingly.

AND the Lieutenant Governor and Commander-in-Chief of the Island of Guernsey, the Bailiff and Jurats, and all other Her Majesty’s Officers for the time being in the said Island, and all other persons whom it may concern, are to take notice and govern themselves accordingly.

PROJET DE LOI

ENTITLED

The Attendance and Invalid Care Allowances (Amendment) (Guernsey) Law, 1991

THE STATES, in pursuance of their Resolution of the 28th day of June, 1990(a), have approved the following provisions, which, subject to the Sanction of Her Most Excellent Majesty in Council, shall have force of law in the Islands of Guernsey, Alderney, Herm and Jethou.

Amendment

1. Section 1(4)(a) of the Attendance and Invalid Care Allowances (Guernsey) Law, 1984, as amended (b), is repealed.

Citation

2. This Law may be cited as the Attendance and Invalid Care Allowances (Amendment) (Guernsey) Law, 1991.

Operation

3. This Law shall be deemed to have come into force on 5th November, 1990.
