Ordinance of the States **XXXVII** 1985

Made 27th November, 1985.

Coming Into Operation ... 6th January, 1986.

The Attendance and Invalid Care Allowances (Guernsey) Ordinance, 1985

THE STATES, in pursuance of their Resolution of the 27th day of November, 1985, and in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by sections 1(4)(b), 2(3)(c), 3 and 15(2) of the Attendance and Invalid Care Allowances (Guernsey) Law, 1984(a), hereby order:—

1. The amount determined for the purposes of section 1(4)(b) of the Law (which provides that an attendance allowance shall not be payable in respect of any person whose current annual income exceeds that amount) shall be twelve thousand pounds.

Entitlement to attendance allowance.

2. The amount determined for the purposes of section 2(3)(c) of the Law (which provides that a person shall not be entitled to an invalid care allowance if his current annual income exceeds that amount) shall be twelve thousand pounds.

Entitlement to invalid care allowance.

(a) No. II of 1984.

Rates of allowances.

3. (1) The weekly rate of an attendance allowance determined for the purposes of section 3 of the Law shall be twenty-five pounds and seventy-five new pence.

(2) The weekly rate of an invalid care allowance determined for the purposes of section 3 of the Law shall be twenty pounds and eighty new pence.

Medical practitioners acting as members of the Board.

4. A medical practitioner who is for the time being a member of the Board shall not act as a member of the Board for the purpose of the consideration of any case referred to the Board if he—

(a) is or may be directly affected by that case;
or

(b) has taken any part in such a case as a medical practitioner who has regularly attended the claimant or to whom any question has been referred for examination and report or as an employer or witness.

Interpretation.

5. (1) In this Ordinance the expression “the Law” means the Attendance and Invalid Care Allowances (Guernsey) Law, 1984, and any other expressions have the same meanings as in the Law.

(2) Except where the context otherwise requires, any reference in this Ordinance to any enactment shall be construed as including a reference to that enactment as amended, repealed, replaced, extended or applied by or under any other enactment including this Ordinance.

(3) The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948(b), shall apply to the interpretation of this Ordinance

throughout the Islands of Guernsey, Alderney, Herm and Jethou.

6. This Ordinance shall have effect in the Islands Extent.
of Guernsey, Alderney, Herm and Jethou.

7. This Ordinance may be cited as the Attendance Citation.
and Invalid Care Allowances (Guernsey) Ordinance,
1985.

8. This Ordinance shall come into force on the Commence-
