**The Central Outdoor Assistance Board
Regulations (Amendment) Ordinance, 1967**

WHEREAS the Central Outdoor Assistance Board on the twentieth day of February, 1967, in pursuance of Article VI of the Public Assistance Law, 1937(a) made the Regulations set out in the Schedule to this Ordinance:

NOW THEREFORE the States, on the representations of the Central Outdoor Assistance Board and in pursuance of the powers now vested in them by the said Article VI and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, hereby order:—

1. The regulations made by the Central Outdoor Assistance Board on the twentieth day of February, 1967, and set out in the Schedule to this Ordinance are hereby approved. Amending regulations approved.

2. This Ordinance may be cited as the Central Outdoor Assistance Board Regulations (Amendment) Ordinance, 1967. Citation.

The Central Outdoor Assistance Board
(Amendment) Regulations, 1967.

1. Regulation four of the Central Outdoor Assistance Board Regulations, 1939, is hereby amended by substituting for sub-paragraph (b) of paragraph (6) thereof a new sub-paragraph (b) and a Proviso as follows—

“(b) If both the Medical Officers of the Parish of Saint Peter Port are prevented by illness, or by being engaged on another case, from attending to a case of the kind referred to in sub-paragraph (a) of this paragraph occurring in that parish, or if the Medical Officer of a Country Parish is so prevented in respect of a case occurring in his parish he may arrange for the case to be attended by the Medical Officer of another Parish, or, with the consent of the President of the Parochial Board concerned, at the cost of the Central Board, by some other registered medical practitioner;

Provided always that if by reason of the patient's past association with some other medical practitioner, or for any other reason, the Central Board considers it expedient or desirable in any particular case it may arrange for the case to be attended, at the cost of the Central Board, by any registered medi-

cal practitioner authorised to practise in this Island.”.

2. (1) These Regulations may be cited as the Central Outdoor Assistance Board (Amendment) Regulations, 1967, and these Regulations and the Central Outdoor Assistance Board Regulations, 1939 and 1963(b), may be cited together as the Central Outdoor Assistance Board Regulations, 1939 to 1967. Citation and commencement.

(2) These Regulations shall come into operation on the first day of May, 1967.
