**The Central Outdoor Assistance Board Regulations
(Amendment) Ordinance, 1997**

THE STATES, in pursuance of their Resolution of the 1st day of August, 1997(a), and in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by Article XXII of the Public Assistance Law, 1937, as amended(b), hereby order:-

Amendment to the Regulations of 1963.

1. The Central Outdoor Assistance Board Regulations, 1963, as amended, set out in the Schedule to the Central Outdoor Assistance Board Regulations Ordinance, 1963(c), are further amended as follows-

- (a) after regulation 5 insert the following regulation-

"Winter fuel allowance.

5A. (1) A relieving official of a parish in which a person in receipt of outdoor assistance resides may, at any time during the period 1st November in any year to 31st March in the next year (both dates inclusive), on the application of that person, grant him a winter fuel allowance at a rate not exceeding £8.00 per week.

- (2) A winter fuel allowance-

- (a) shall be payable only in respect of any week in which the applicant is in receipt of outdoor assistance;

- (c) Recueil d'Ordonnances, Tome XIII, p. 274; Tome XXII, p. 163; No. XXXIX of 1991; No. XXXI of 1993; No. XXXIV of 1994; and No. XXIV of 1995.

(b) shall be payable in addition to any other payment in respect of outdoor assistance; and

(c) shall not be payable for any week prior to the week in respect of which application is made to the relieving official.

(3) The provisions of these regulations shall apply in relation to a winter fuel allowance as they apply in relation to outdoor assistance.;"

(b) in paragraph 2(2) of the Schedule to the Regulations(d), for "£168.50" substitute "£173.75";

(c) for paragraph 10 of the Schedule to the Regulations, substitute the following-

"Ordinary maximum rates of outdoor assistance.

10. The ordinary maximum rates of outdoor assistance shall be-

(a) for two persons living together as husband and wife, £100.00;

(b) for a person living alone or a householder not falling within (a) of this paragraph who is responsible for household necessities and rent, £62.25;

(c) for any other person who is-

(i) aged 18 and over, £51.25;

(ii) aged 16 or over but under 18, £37.50;

(d) The Schedule to the Regulations was substituted by Tome XXII, p. 163 and amended by No. XXXIX of 1991; No. XXXI of 1993; No. XXXIV of 1994; No. XXIV of 1995; and No. XXVIII of 1996.

(iii) aged 13 or over but under 16, £30.00;

(iv) aged 11 or over but under 13, £24.00;

(v) aged 5 or over but under 11, £22.00;

(vi) aged under 5, £18.00."

Repeals.

2. Paragraphs (b) and (e) of section 1 of the Central Outdoor Assistance Board Regulations (Amendment) Ordinance, 1996(e) are repealed.

Citation.

3. This Ordinance may be cited as the Central Outdoor Assistance Board Regulations (Amendment) Ordinance, 1997.

Commencement.

4. This Ordinance (apart from section 1(a), which shall come into force on the 1st November, 1997) shall come into force on the 9th January, 1998.
