### **The Control of Motor Vehicle Racing (Amendment) Ordinance, 1970**

THE STATES, in pursuance of their Resolution of the twenty-sixth day of February, nineteen hundred and seventy, hereby order:—

1. The Control of Motor-Bicycle Racing (Guernsey) Ordinance, 1948<sup>(a)</sup>, as amended<sup>(b)</sup> (hereinafter referred to as “the principal Ordinance”), is hereby further amended as follows:—

- (a) in section one thereof and in the marginal note thereto the word “motor-bicycle” is repealed and the words “motor vehicle” are substituted therefor;
- (b) in section four thereof, the word “motor-bicycle” is repealed and the words “motor vehicle” is substituted therefor and in that section the words “with or without hard labour” are repealed;
- (c) section five thereof and the marginal note thereto are repealed and the following sections and marginal notes are substituted therefor:—

“Interpretation.

5. In this Ordinance, unless the context otherwise requires, the following expressions have the meanings hereby respectively assigned to them:—

“motor vehicle” means a mechanically propelled vehicle;

“motor vehicle race” means any race in which any person driving or riding a motor vehicle shall compete against any other such person, or against time, and at which more than ten persons are present.

Citation.

6. This Ordinance may be cited as the Control of Motor Vehicle Racing Ordinance, 1948.”.

Citation and collective title.

2. (1) This Ordinance may be cited as the Control of Motor Vehicle Racing (Amendment) Ordinance, 1970.

(2) This Ordinance and the principal Ordinance may be cited together as the Control of Motor Vehicle Racing Ordinances, 1948 and 1970.

Commencement.

3. This Ordinance shall come into force on the thirtieth day of June, nineteen hundred and seventy.
