ORDINANCE OF THE STATES

Made 4th September, 1991
Coming into force 4th September, 1991

THE TOURGIS HILL SPEED TRIAL (ALDERNEY)
ORDINANCE, 1991

THE STATES, in pursuance of their Resolution of 4th September, 1991 and in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 46 of and paragraph (1) of Schedule 2 to, the Government of Alderney Law, 1987, hereby order:-

Closure of road for authorised speed trial

1. The road at Tourgis Hill shall be closed between 0900 and 1800 hours on Saturday 21st September 1991 to all vehicular traffic except under and in accordance with the specific permission in writing of the States Public Works Committee and for drivers of vehicles taking part in, or involved in the organisation of, and trial of speed held with the written consent of, and under such conditions (whether with regard to the safeguarding of people taking part in the trial and of other people, or otherwise) as are imposed by, the States Public Works Committee.

Exemption from speed limit and noise restrictions

2. Regulations 10 and 13 of the Traffic Regulations, 1986 as amended do not apply to the driver of a vehicle taking part in that trial of speed in accordance with those conditions.

Offence

3. A person who uses a motor vehicle on Tourgis Hill on Saturday 21st September 1991 otherwise than in accordance with Section 1 of this Ordinance, and any conditions imposed by the States Public Works Committee as mentioned therein, is guilty of an offence and liable on conviction to a fine not exceeding level 4 on the Alderney uniform scale.

Citation

4. This Ordinance may be cited as the Tourgis Hill Speed Trial (Alderney) Ordinance, 1991.
