ORDINANCE OF THE STATES

Made 2nd March, 1983
Coming into force 2nd March, 1983

THE TOURIST (ALDERNEY) LAW (FEES) ORDINANCE, 1983

THE STATES, in pursuance of their Resolution of the second day of March, nineteen hundred and eighty-three, and in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section two of the Tourist (Alderney) Law, 1956, as amended (a), hereby order:-

Fees for accommodation permits

1. The fees payable under subsection (3) of section two of the Law in respect of the grant of an accommodation permit shall be a fee of one pound for each one of the number of persons authorised to be accommodated under and in accordance with such permit.

Interpretation

2. In this Ordinance the expression "the Law" means the Tourist (Alderney) Law, 1956, as amended, and the other expressions have the same meanings as in the Law.

Citation

3. This Ordinance may be cited as the Tourist (Alderney) Law (Fees) Ordinance, 1983.

Commencement

4. This Ordinance shall come into force on the second day of March, nineteen hundred and eighty-three.
