**The Tourist Law (Fees) (Amendment)
Ordinance, 1953.**

THE STATES, in pursuance of their Resolution of the 8th day of July, 1953, and under and by virtue of the powers now vested in them by section seventeen of the Tourist Law, 1948, and all other powers enabling them in that behalf, hereby order:—

1. In section two of the Tourist Law (Fees) Ordinance, 1948 (hereinafter referred to as “the principal Ordinance”) the words “two shillings and sixpence” are hereby repealed and the words “five shillings” substituted therefor.

2. This Ordinance and the principal Ordinance may be cited together as the Tourist Law (Fees) Ordinances, 1948 and 1953.

3. This Ordinance shall come into force on the 1st day of January, 1954.
