**The Tourist Law (Fees) (Amendment)
Ordinance, 1970**

THE STATES, in pursuance of their Resolution of the twenty-fifth day of November, nineteen hundred and seventy, and in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section seventeen of the Tourist Law, 1948, as amended(*a*), and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, hereby order:—

1. In section two of the Tourist Law (Fees) Ordinance, 1948, as amended(*b*), the words “ five shillings ” are hereby repealed and the words “ ten shillings ” substituted therefor. Increase of Fees.
2. The Tourist Law (Fees) (Amendment) Ordinance, 1953, is hereby repealed. Repeal.
3. (1) This Ordinance may be cited as the Tourist Law (Fees) (Amendment) Ordinance, 1970. Citation and collective title.
