Ordinance of the States **XXXVIII** 1987

Made 9th December, 1987.

Coming into Operation ... 1st January, 1988.

The Tourist Law (Fees) (Amendment) Ordinance, 1987

THE STATES, in pursuance of their Resolution of the 9th day of December, 1987, and in exercise of the powers conferred by section 17 of the Tourist Law, 1948, as amended(*a*) and now vested in them by virtue of section 63 of the Reform (Guernsey) Law, 1948(*b*), and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, hereby order:—

1. In section 2 of the Tourist Law (Fees) Ordinance, 1948, as amended(*c*), for “one pound” substitute “£1.50 (in respect of premises classified by the States Tourist Board under section 13 of the Tourist Law, 1948 as a guest house), or £2.50 (in any other case),”. Increase of fees.
2. The Tourist Law (Fees) (Amendment) Ordinance, 1975 is repealed. Repeal.

- Citation. 3. This Ordinance may be cited as the Tourist Law (Fees) (Amendment) Ordinance, 1987.
- Collective title. 4. This Ordinance and the Tourist Law (Fees) Ordinance, 1948 may be cited together as the Tourist Law (Fees) Ordinances, 1948 and 1987.
- Commencement. 5. This Ordinance shall come into force on 1st January, 1988.
