**The Tourist Law (Fees) (Amendment) Ordinance,  
1990**

THE STATES, in pursuance of their Resolution of the 1st day of November, 1990, and in exercise of the powers conferred by section 17 of the Tourist Law, 1948, as amended(a) and now vested in them by virtue of section 63 of the Reform (Guernsey) Law, 1948(b), and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, hereby order:—

*Increase of Fees*

1. For section 2 of the Tourist Law (Fees) Ordinance, 1948, as amended(c), substitute—

“ 2. Every person, within fourteen days of being granted a boarding permit, shall pay a fee of £2.00 (in respect of premises classified by the States Tourist Board under section 13 of the Tourist Law, 1948 as a guest house), or £3.25 (in any other case), for each one of the persons so prescribed.”

*Repeal*

2. The Tourist Law (Fees) (Amendment) Ordinance, 1987 is repealed.

*Citation*

3. This Ordinance may be cited as the Tourist Law (Fees) (Amendment) Ordinance, 1990.

*Collective title*

4. This Ordinance and the Tourist Law (Fees) Ordinance, 1948 may be cited together as the Tourist Law (Fees) Ordinances, 1948 and 1990.

*Commencement*

5. This Ordinance shall come into force on 1st January, 1991.
