# ORDER IN COUNCIL



IN THE ROYAL COURT OF THE ISLAND OF GUERNSEY

*The 31st day of January, 1995 before Sir Graham Dorey, Bailiff; present:—Harry Wilson Bisson, Stanley Walter John Jehan, John Edward Morris, Charles Anthony Spensley, Kenneth John Rowe, Lawrence Oscar Ozanne, John Richard Rowe Henry, David Charles Lowe, Esquires, Mrs. Eileen May Glass and Laurence Lenfestey Guille, Esquire, Jurats.*

The Bailiff having this day placed before the Court an Order of Her Majesty in Council dated the 24th day of November, 1994, approving and ratifying a *Projet de Loi* entitled “The Criminal Justice (Suspended Sentence Supervision Orders) (Amendment) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Law, 1994”, THE COURT, after the reading of the said Order in Council and after having heard Her Majesty’s Comptroller thereon, ORDERED:

1. That the said Order in Council be registered on the records of this Island; and
2. That an extract of this present Act, together with a copy of the said Order in Council, be sent by Her Majesty’s Greffier to the Clerk of the Court of Alderney and to the S n schal of Sark for registration on the records of those Islands of which Order in Council the tenor followeth:—

## The Queen's Most Excellent Majesty in Council

WHEREAS there was this day read at the Board a Report from the Right Honourable the Lords of the Committee of Council for the affairs of Guernsey and Jersey dated the 2nd day of November 1994 in the words following, viz.:—

“YOUR MAJESTY having been pleased, by Your General Order of Reference of the 22nd day of February 1952, to refer unto this Committee the humble petition of the States of the Island of Guernsey setting forth:—

“1. That, in pursuance of their Resolution of the 16th day of December 1993, the States of Deliberation at a meeting held on the 29th day of June 1994 approved a Bill or “Projet de Loi” entitled “The Criminal Justice (Suspended Sentence Supervision Orders) (Amendment) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Law, 1994”, and requested the Bailiff to present a most humble Petition to Your Majesty in Council praying for Your Royal Sanction thereto.  
2. That the said Bill or “Projet de Loi” is as set forth in the Schedule hereunto annexed. And most humbly praying that Your Majesty might be graciously pleased to grant Your Royal Sanction to the Bill or “Projet de Loi” of the States of Guernsey entitled “The Criminal Justice (Suspended Sentence Supervision Orders) (Amendment) (Bailiwick of Guernsey Law, 1994”, and to order that the same shall have force of law in the Bailiwick of Guernsey.”

“THE LORDS OF THE COMMITTEE, in obedience to Your Majesty’s said Order of Reference, have taken the said Petition and the said Projet de Loi into consideration and do this day agree

humbly to report, as their opinion, to Your Majesty, that it may be advisable for Your Majesty to comply with the prayer of the said Petition and to approve of and ratify the said Projet de Loi.”

HER MAJESTY having taken the said Report into consideration is pleased, by and with the advice of Her Privy Council, to approve of and ratify the said Projet de Loi, and to order, and it is hereby ordered, that the same shall have the force of Law within the Bailiwick of Guernsey.

AND HER MAJESTY doth hereby further direct that this Order, and the said Projet de Loi (a copy whereof is hereunto annexed), be entered upon the Register of the Island of Guernsey and observed accordingly.

AND the Lieutenant Governor and Commander-in-Chief of the Island of Guernsey, the Bailiff and Jurats, and all other Her Majesty's Officers for the time being in the said Island, and all other persons whom it may concern, are to take notice and govern themselves accordingly.

PROJET DE LOI

ENTITLED

**The Criminal Justice (Suspended Sentence Supervision Orders) (Amendment) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Law, 1994**

**THE STATES**, in pursuance of their Resolution of the 16th day of December, 1993(a), have approved the following provisions which, subject to the Sanction of Her Most Excellent Majesty in Council, shall have force of law in the Bailiwick of Guernsey.

**Amendment.**

1. In section 2(2) of the Criminal Justice (Suspended Sentence Supervision Orders) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Law, 1984(b), for the words "level 1 on the uniform scale"(c) substitute "level 4 on the uniform scale or such other level or amount as the States may determine by Ordinance".

**Citation.**

2. This Law may be cited as the Criminal Justice (Suspended Sentence Supervision Orders) (Amendment) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Law, 1994.
