**The Document Duty (Amendment) Ordinance, 2000**

## The Document Duty (Amendment) Ordinance, 2000

THE STATES, in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section 6 of the Document Duty (Guernsey) Law, 1973, as amended<sup>a</sup>, and in pursuance of their Resolution of the 14<sup>th</sup> December, 2000, hereby order:-

### Rate of Document Duty in relation to conveyance of realty.

1. In the First Schedule<sup>b</sup> of the Document Duty (Guernsey) Law, 1973, as amended.

(a) for paragraph 1 substitute the following paragraph -

“1. Conveyance of realty other than a conveyance specified in paragraph 2, 3 or 5 of this Schedule.	(a) Where the value of the transaction does not exceed £115,000, zero.

(b) in paragraphs 2, 3, 5 and 7, for “30p per £20” substitute “20p  
per £20”

**Extent.**

2. This Ordinance shall have effect in the Islands of Guernsey and  
Alderney.

**Repeal.**

3. The Document Duty (Amendment) (No. 2) Ordinance, 1997 is  
repealed.

**Citation.**

4. This Ordinance may be cited as the Document Duty (Amendment)  
Ordinance, 2000.

**Commencement.**

5. This Ordinance shall come into force on the 13<sup>th</sup> December 2000.
