

The Driving Licences (Amendment) (No. 2) (Guernsey) Ordinance, 1996

THE STATES, in pursuance of their Resolution of the 28th day of October, 1993¹, and in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section 2 of the Motor Taxation and Licensing (Guernsey) Law, 1987, as amended², hereby order:-

Amendment to 1995 Ordinance.

1. The Driving Licences (Guernsey) Ordinance, 1995, as amended³, is hereby amended by inserting the following section immediately after section 2-

"Compulsory training courses for riders of motor cycles.

2A. (1) Subject to subsection (2), a person being the holder of a provisional licence authorising him to drive a motor vehicle of a class included in categories P, A or A1 shall not drive that motor vehicle on a public highway unless he is also the holder of a certificate of completion by him of a training course for motor cyclists approved for the purposes of this section by the Committee.

(2) Subsection (1) shall not apply to the holder of a provisional licence authorising him to drive a motor vehicle of a class included in category A if he holds, and has held for a period of at least twelve months, a full licence authorising him to drive a motor vehicle of a class included in category A1."

Citation.

2. This Ordinance may be cited as the Driving Licences (Amendment) (No. 2) (Guernsey) Ordinance, 1996.

Commencement.

3. This Ordinance shall come into force on 1st January, 1997.
