**The Driving Licences (Guernsey) (Amendment) Ordinance, 1998**

**THE STATES**, in pursuance of their Resolution of the 29th day of October, 1997<sup>1</sup> hereby order:-

**Amendments to Ordinance of 1995**

**1.** In the Driving Licences (Guernsey) Ordinance, 1995<sup>2</sup>, as amended<sup>3</sup>:

(a) in the ARRANGEMENT OF SECTIONS after the entry relating to section 14 insert -

"14A.Exemption from additional requirements";

(b) in section 1(2)(b) for "suspended" wheresoever appearing substitute "revoked";

(c) in section 1(2)(c)(i) the comma and word ",Alderney" are repealed;

(d) at the end of section 1(2)(c)(iii) for the word "and" substitute "or";

(e) immediately after section 1(2)(c)(iii) insert -

"(iv) he satisfies the Committee that he is the holder of a valid pass certificate or certificates as the case may be, authorising him to drive a motor vehicle of that class and issued by the competent

authority in Great Britain, Northern Ireland, the Isle of Man or Jersey; or

(v) he satisfies the Committee that he is the holder of a valid pass certificate or certificates as the case may be, authorising him to drive a motor vehicle of that class and issued by the competent authority of a Member State of the European Community and he has taken up normal residence in this Island; or

(vi) he satisfies the Committee that he is the holder of a valid pass certificate or certificates as the case may be, authorising him to drive a motor vehicle of that class and issued by the competent authority of such country with which the United Kingdom may from time to time have a reciprocal arrangement; and"

(f) in section 1(3) for "(c)(i), (ii) or (iii)" substitute "(c)(i) to (vi)";

(g) in section 1(4) for "(c)(i), (ii) or (iii)" substitute "(c)(i) to (vi)";

(h) in section 1(9) for the word "years" substitute "months";

(i) section 4(4) is repealed;

(j) in section 8(2) insert "B+E," after "A,";

(k) in section 8(3) for "C, C1, D, D1, E, H or N," substitute "C, C+E, C1, C1+E, D, D+E, D1 or D1+E,";

- (l) in section 14 the words "Subject to section 14A below" are inserted at the beginning of the section;
- (m) immediately after section 14 there is inserted the following section -

**"Exemption from additional requirements**

**14A (1)** The additional requirements referred to in section 14 above shall not apply where a person has passed a test to drive a motor vehicle of a class which is within the same category as the licence he held until such licence was revoked pursuant to an order of the court following the conviction of that person of an offence specified in Schedule 1 to this Ordinance.

(2) A person who is exempt from the additional requirements pursuant to subsection 1 and has passed a test to drive a motor vehicle of a class included in a category in the first column of the table in Schedule 6B to this Ordinance shall be entitled to a full licence authorising him to drive vehicles of a class included in that category and any other category which is referred to in the second column of that table as being an additional category covered by that particular category:

PROVIDED THAT the additional category shall only apply where the person was previously entitled to drive a vehicle of a class in the same category as the additional category pursuant to the licence that was revoked."

- (n) in section 16(4) the word "Alderney" wheresoever appearing is repealed;
- (o) in section 20(a) for the words "refused to grant" where secondly appearing substitute "revoked";

(p) in section 24(1) for the words and commas immediately after the paragraph entitled "**vehicle with automatic transmission**" substitute "means a class of motor vehicle in respect of which either:

(a) the driver is not provided with any means whereby he may vary the gear ratio between the engine and the road wheels independently of the accelerator and the brakes; or

(b) he is provided with such means, but they do not include a clutch pedal or lever which he may operate manually,

and accordingly a vehicle with manual transmission is any other class of vehicle.";

(q) in section (6) of Schedule 3 under the heading "Fee", "£12" is repealed;

(r) in section (6) of Schedule 3 immediately after the word "court" insert -

"where -

(a) the licence will subsist for less than six years;     £12  
or

(b) the licence will subsist for more than six years, for each year until expiry     £2;"

- (s) in Schedule 4 after "Category D1" where first appearing for the words "Large passenger-carrying vehicle" substitute "Mini bus" and in the paragraph below the words from "which has a maximum" to "disabled passengers" are repealed;
- (t) at the end of the heading "SCHEDULE 6" add "A";
- (u) in the fourth column of Schedule 6 the following letters and numbers are substituted -
  - (i) in category C:- "C1" by "B", and
  - (ii) in category D:- "D1" by "B".
- (v) immediately after the table in Schedule 6 insert -
