**The Drug Trafficking Offences (Bailiwick of  
Guernsey) Law, 1988 (Specified Countries  
and Territories) (Amendment) Ordinance, 1992**

THE STATES, in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section 20 of the Drug Trafficking Offences (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Law, 1988(a) and on representations of the States Advisory and Finance Committee, hereby order:-

Amendments to Ordinance of 1991.

1.(1) The following entries are inserted in the appropriate places in the First Schedule to the Drug Trafficking Offences (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Law, 1988 (Specified Countries and Territories) Ordinance, 1991(b) ("the Ordinance"):

---

(a) Order in Council No. XII of 1988.

(b) Ordinance No. IX of 1991.

"Bahrain	the Ministry of the Interior"
"Barbados	the Attorney General"
"Cayman Islands	the Attorney General of the Cayman Islands"
"Hong Kong	the Attorney General of Hong Kong"
"Italy	the Ministry of Justice"
"Montserrat	the Attorney General of Montserrat"
"Saudi Arabia	the Ministry of the Interior".

(2) The following entries are inserted in the appropriate places in the Second Schedule to the Ordinance:

"Bahrain	when a bill of indictment is lodged in court against any person for an offence."
"Barbados	(a) when an information has been laid before a magistrate; (b) when a person is charged with an offence; (c) when a bill of indictment is preferred."
"Cayman Islands	(a) when a charge has been signed under subsection (3) or (4) of section 13 of the Criminal Procedure Code in respect of the offence; (b) when a person is charged with the offence after being arrested without warrant under subsection (5) of that section."

- "Hong Kong
- (a) when a magistrate issues a warrant or summons;
  - (b) when a person is charged with an offence;
  - (c) when an indictment is preferred."
- "Italy
- (a) when a person is notified in accordance with article 369 of the Italian Code of Criminal Procedure, that a prosecution against him is in progress;
  - (b) when a proposal for the application of a preventative measure ("misura di prevenzione") is laid before a court."
- "Montserrat
- (a) when a judge issues a summons or warrant in respect of an offence;
  - (b) when a person is charged with an offence after being taken into custody without a warrant."
- "Saudi Arabia
- when an information has been laid before a judicial authority."

2. This Ordinance may be cited as the Drug Trafficking Offences (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Law, 1988 (Specified Countries and Territories) (Amendment) Ordinance, 1992.
