Ordinance of the States **LVI**
1967

Made 13th December, 1967.
Came into Operation 13th December, 1967.

**The Drugs (Prevention of Misuse)
(Exemptions) (Guernsey) Ordinance, 1967**

THE STATES, in exercise of the powers conferred on them by subsection (1) of section two of the Drugs (Prevention of Misuse) (Guernsey) Law, 1967, and of all other powers thereunto them enabling, hereby order:—

1. Subsection (1) of section two of the Drugs (Prevention of Misuse) (Guernsey) Law, 1967(a), shall not be taken to prohibit the possession of a substance for the time being specified in the Schedule to that Law by—

Exemptions

2(1) of the

- (a) a carrier or a person employed by a carrier in that carrier's business as such where the substance is in the possession of the carrier or of that person for the purpose of his acting in his capacity as a carrier or person employed as aforesaid, as the case may be;

(a) Ordre en Conseil No. XI of 1967.

- (b) a person while it is contained in a postal packet (as defined in subsection (1) of section eighty-seven of the Post Office Act, 1953) which is in the course of transmission by post (within the meaning of that expression in subsection (2) of that section) provided that it is in his possession in the performance by him of a duty connected with such transmission;
- (c) the owner or master of a ship required by the Merchant Shipping Acts, 1894 to 1964, to carry a first-aid outfit in one or more of its lifeboats, boats or inflatable life rafts for the purpose of the administration thereof, by way of treatment, to persons in any of those lifeboats, boats or inflatable life rafts.

Extent.

2. This Ordinance shall apply throughout the Bailiwick.

Interpretation.

3. The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948(b), shall apply to the interpretation of this Ordinance throughout the Bailiwick.

Citation.

4. This Ordinance may be cited as the Drugs (Prevention of Misuse) (Exemptions) (Guernsey) Ordinance, 1967.
