Ordinance of the States **XX**

1955

Made 27th July, 1955.
Coming into Operation .. 1st November, 1955.
Laid before the States .. 14th September, 1955.

The Family Allowances (Increase of Allowances) Ordinance, 1955.

The States Legislation Committee, in pursuance of the powers conferred upon them by section sixty-six of the Reform (Guernsey) Law, 1948, and in pursuance of the provisions of section one of the Family Allowances (Guernsey) Law, 1950, and in pursuance of the Resolution of the States of the 27th day of July, 1955, and in pursuance of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, hereby order:—

1. In subsection (1) of section one of the Family Allowances (Guernsey) Law, 1950, the words “five shillings” where they occur in that section are hereby deleted and the words “seven shillings” are hereby substituted therefor.
2. This Ordinance shall come into force on the first day of November, 1955.
