The Family Allowances (Increase of Allowances) Ordinance, 1957.

THE STATES LEGISLATION COMMITTEE, in pursuance of the powers conferred upon them by paragraph (3) of Article sixty-six of the Reform (Guernsey) Law, 1948, by subsection (2) of section one and subsection (2) of section three of the Family Allowances (Guernsey) Law, 1950, as amended, and in pursuance of the Resolution of the States of the thirty-first day of July, nineteen hundred and fifty-seven, and in pursuance of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, hereby order:—

1. The Family Allowances (Guernsey) Law, 1950, as amended, is hereby further amended as follows:—

- (a) in subsection (1) of section one thereof the words “seven shillings” are hereby deleted

and the words "seven shillings and sixpence" are hereby substituted therefor;

- (b) in subsection (2) of section three thereof the words "seven shillings" are hereby deleted and the words "seven shillings and sixpence" are hereby substituted therefor;
- (c) in the proviso to sub-paragraph (1) of paragraph one of the Schedule thereto the words "seven shillings" are hereby deleted and the words "seven shillings and sixpence" are hereby substituted therefor.

2. The Family Allowances (Increase of Allowances) Ordinance, 1955, is hereby repealed.

3. This Ordinance shall come into force on the twenty-seventh day of November, nineteen hundred and fifty-seven.
