**The Family Allowances (Guernsey)  
Ordinance, 1990**

THE STATES, in pursuance of their Resolution of the 28th day of June, 1990, and in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section 1 and section 3 of, and paragraph 1 of the Schedule to, the Family Allowances (Guernsey) Law, 1950, as amended<sup>(a)</sup>, hereby order:—

1. The amount of allowance referred to in section 1(1) of the Family Allowances (Guernsey) Law, 1950, as amended (hereinafter referred to as “the Law of 1950”), in respect of each child in the family, shall be at the rate of seven pounds and fifty pence a week. Amount of allowance.

2. The amount referred to in section 3(2) of the Law of 1950 in respect of the contribution to the cost of providing for a child shall be at the rate of seven pounds and fifty pence a week or more. Amount as to contribution to the cost of providing for a child.

- Amount as to contribution to the cost of providing for a child.      3. The amount referred to in the proviso to paragraph 1(1) of the Schedule to the Law of 1950 in respect of the contribution to the cost of providing for a child shall be at a rate not less than seven pounds and fifty pence a week.
- Repeal.                      4. The Family Allowances (No. 2) (Guernsey) Ordinance, 1988(b), is hereby repealed.
- Extent.                      5. This Ordinance shall have effect in the Islands of Guernsey, Alderney, Herm and Jethou.
- Citation.                    6. This Ordinance may be cited as the Family Allowances (Guernsey) Ordinance, 1990.

ment.                        7. This Ordinance shall come into force on the 6th day of November, 1990.
