Coming into operation 2nd January, 1996.

The Family Allowances Ordinance, 1995.

THE STATES, in pursuance of their Resolution of the 26th day of July, 1995(a), and in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section 1 and section 3 of, and paragraph 1 of the Schedule to, the Family Allowances (Guernsey) Law, 1950, as amended(b), hereby order:-

Amount of allowance.

1. The amount of allowance referred to in section 1(1) of the Family Allowances (Guernsey) Law, 1950, as amended (hereinafter referred to as "the Law of 1950"), in respect of each child in the family, shall be at the rate of £9.00 a week.

Amount as to contribution to the cost of providing for a child.

2. The amount in respect of the contribution to the cost of providing for a child referred to in-

(c) Ordinance No. XX of 1993.

- (a) section 3(2) of the Law of 1950 shall be at the rate of £9.00 a week or more;
- (b) the proviso to paragraph 1(1) of the Schedule to the Law of 1950 shall be at the rate of £9.00 a week.

Repeal.

- 3. The Family Allowances (Guernsey) Ordinance, 1993(c), is hereby repealed.

Extent.

- 4. This Ordinance shall have effect in the Islands of Guernsey, Alderney, Herm and Jethou.

Citation.

- 5. This Ordinance may be cited as the Family Allowances Ordinance, 1995.

Commencement.

- 6. This Ordinance shall come into force on the 2nd January, 1996.
