



forenoon and seven in the evening, ride on or in or drive a vehicle or ride a horse, on the foreshore of this Island :

PROVIDED that the provisions of this section shall not apply to a vehicle used on the foreshore solely for the lawful collection of vraic, sand, stones or other beach material or the haulage of fish, boats or their stores or gear ;

(b) at any time take off, land or manoeuvre any aircraft or air glider from, on or upon the foreshore of this Island.

4. Nothing in this Ordinance contained shall be deemed in any way to prejudice any right or interest of any person in or over any part of the said foreshore.

5. A person contravening any provision of this Ordinance shall be guilty of an offence and liable on conviction to a fine not exceeding ten pounds.

6. This Ordinance shall come into force on the 21st day of March, 1951.
