**The Fort Le Marchant Rifle Range  
(Safety and Control) (Amendment)  
Ordinance, 1971**

THE STATES, in pursuance of their Resolution of the twenty-eighth day of July, nineteen hundred and seventy-one, hereby order:—

1. The Fort Le Marchant Rifle Range (Safety and Control) Ordinance, 1955, as amended<sup>(a)</sup>, is hereby further amended as follows:— Amendments to Ordinance of 1955.

- (a) in subsection (2) of section two, in subsection (2) of section five, in section seven and in subsection (2) of section twenty thereof the words “the Committee” are repealed and the words “the Board” are substituted therefor;
- (b) in paragraph (e) of section six thereof the words “the Pilotage Ordinances, 1946 to

1952” are repealed and the words “the Pilotage Ordinance, 1967” are substituted therefor;

- (c) in section twenty-three thereof the definition of the expression “Committee” is repealed and the following definition is substituted therefor—

“ “the Board” means the States Board of Administration;”.
