**The Fort Le Marchant Rifle Range
(Safety and Control) (Amendment)
Ordinance, 1963.**

THE STATES, in pursuance of their Resolution of the thirtieth day of January, nineteen hundred and sixty-three, and on the representations of the States Military Service Committee, hereby order:—

1. The Fort Le Marchant Rifle Range (Safety and Control) Ordinance, 1955(a) (hereinafter referred to as “the principal Ordinance”) is hereby amended, as follows:—
 - (a) section eleven and the marginal note thereto are hereby repealed and the following section and marginal note are hereby substituted therefor—

- (a) on the six hundred yard range until a look-out man has been posted at the flagstaff on the top of La Grande Hougue; or
- (b) on the one hundred yard range until a look-out man has been posted as aforesaid and an additional look-out man has been posted to the north of the noticeboard at Hougue Patris in such a position as to be visible to the first-mentioned look-out man and to command an uninterrupted view of that part of the foreshore in Fontenelle Bay which is invisible to the first-mentioned look-out man;

and each such look-out man before being posted as aforesaid shall be supplied with a copy of the Orders for Look-Out Men set out in the Third Schedule to this Ordinance which Orders shall be read to him before taking up his post by the Range Officer and shall be complied with by each look-out man save

that the additional look-out man referred to in paragraph (b) of this subsection shall not be required to comply with paragraph four of the said Orders.

(2) Firing, on any occasion shall cease—

(a) on the six hundred yard range when the look-out man posted at the flagstaff on the top of La Grande Hougue leaves his post; and

(b) on the one hundred yard range when either the look-out man posted as aforesaid or the additional look-out man posted to the north of the notice-board at Hougue Patris, leaves his post.”;

(b) section seventeen thereof is hereby re-numbered as “17 (1)” and the following additional subsection is hereby inserted immediately thereafter—

“(2) If, when firing is taking place on either the six hundred yard range or the one hundred yard range or both, any person crosses, in a direction from west to east, a line joining

No. 4 Martello Tower and the target shed, firing shall cease.”;

- (c) immediately after the words “Fort Le Marchant Rifle Range” in the definition of the expression “the Range” in section twenty-three thereof there are hereby inserted the following words—

“comprising a six hundred yard range and a one hundred yard range”;

- (d) the entries in the right hand column of the First Schedule thereto opposite to the entries “Rifle” and “Light Machine Gun” are hereby repealed and the following entries are hereby substituted therefor—

“.303 Marks IV and V and 7.62 millimetres

.303 Bren and 7.62 millimetres”;

- (e) the Second Schedule thereto is hereby repealed and the Schedule set out in the Schedule to this Ordinance is hereby substituted therefor;

- (f) in the heading to the Third Schedule thereto the word “Man” is hereby deleted and the word “Men” is hereby substituted therefor.

2. (1) This Ordinance may be cited as the Fort Le Marchant Rifle Range (Safety and Control) (Amendment) Ordinance, 1963.

(2) This Ordinance and the principal Ordinance may be cited together as the Fort Le Marchant Rifle Range (Safety and Control) Ordinances, 1955 and 1963.
