Coming into operation 1st January, 1997.

The Health Service (Benefit) (Amendment) (No. 2) Ordinance, 1996.

THE STATES, in pursuance of their Resolution of the 27th day of June, 1996(a), and in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by sections 13 and 35 of the Health Service (Benefit) (Guernsey) Law, 1990(b), as amended, hereby order:-

Amendment of 1990 Ordinance.

1. (1) For section 1 of the Health Service (Benefit) Ordinance, 1990(c), as amended, substitute the following-

"Exclusions from the expression "consultation for a medical purpose".

1. In section 6(1) of the Law the expression "consultation for a medical purpose" shall not include a consultation or treatment at any of the following locations-

- (a) the Princess Elizabeth Hospital, Guernsey, unless the consultation or treatment-

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- (a) Article VI of Billet d'Etat No. XIII of 1996.
(b) Order in Council No. XXIV of 1990; amended by Ordinances XIV of 1993 and XXXIV and XXXV of 1995.
(c) Recueil d'Ordonnances Tome XXV, pp. 191 and 310; No.'s XX, XXXIII and XLII of 1995; and No. IX of 1996.

- (i) is given by an approved medical practitioner who is at the time participating in the provision of 24 hour emergency medical cover arranged by the Board of Health; and
 - (ii) is provided to a patient of that practitioner's practice who, not being an in-patient of the Hospital or a patient attending at the receiving room thereof, would otherwise have consulted him at his surgery;
- (b) the Mignot Memorial Hospital, Alderney;
- (c) the Castel Hospital, Guernsey or the King Edward VII Hospital, Guernsey, unless the consultation or treatment-
- (i) is given by an approved medical practitioner not employed by or contracted to the States; or
 - (ii) is given by an approved medical practitioner employed by or contracted to the States but is given otherwise than in the course of his employment or contract;
- (d) any location other than the premises of the medical practice by which an approved nurse is employed or the premises of the approved medical practitioner by whom the nurse is employed where the consultation or treatment is given by an approved nurse;
- (e) the practice premises of the Medical Specialist Group;
- (f) the practice premises of the Ophthalmic Group."

(2) For Schedule 1 to the Health Service (Benefit) Ordinance, 1990(d), as amended, substitute the Schedule set out in the Schedule to this Ordinance.

Repeal.

2. The following Ordinances are repealed-

- (a) the Health Service (Benefit) (Amendment) Ordinance, 1995(e);
- (b) the Health Service (Benefit) (Amendment) Ordinance, 1995(f);
- (c) the Health Service (Benefit) (Amendment) (No. 2) Ordinance, 1995(g);
- (d) the Health Service (Benefit) (Amendment) Ordinance, 1996(h).

Extent.

3. This Ordinance shall have effect in the Islands of Guernsey, Alderney, Herm and Jethou.

Citation.

4. This Ordinance may be cited as the Health Service (Benefit) (Amendment) (No. 2) Ordinance, 1996.

Commencement.

5. This Ordinance shall come into force on the 1st January, 1997.
