**The Health Service (Pharmaceutical)
(Certificates of Exception) (Guernsey)
Ordinance, 1982**

THE STATES, in pursuance of their Resolution of the third day of February, nineteen hundred and eighty-two, and in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section eleven and section twenty-three of the Health Service (Pharmaceutical) (Guernsey) Law, 1972, as amended(a), hereby order:—

1. Section eleven of the Health Service (Pharmaceutical) (Guernsey) Law, 1972, as amended, is hereby varied as follows:—

- (a) subsection (2) of the said section is varied to the extent that the Authority shall also grant a certificate of exception to any person not entitled to receive supplementary benefit who has satisfied the Authority that he has attained the age of sixty-five years, and any

Certificates of exception to be granted to persons attaining 65 years.

such certificate shall be granted in respect only of such person and not in respect of his dependants;

- (b) the provisions of subsections (4) and (6) of the said section, insofar as they relate to dependants, shall not apply in respect of a certificate of exception granted to a person not entitled to supplementary benefit who has attained the age of sixty-five years.

Citation. 2. This Ordinance may be cited as the Health Service (Pharmaceutical)-(Certificates of Exception) (Guernsey) Ordinance, 1982.

Commencement. 3. This Ordinance shall come into force on the first day of May, nineteen hundred and eighty-two.
