**The Health Service (Pharmaceutical)
(Prescription Charges) (Guernsey)
Ordinance, 1984**

THE STATES, in pursuance of their Resolution of the 27th day of June, 1984, and in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section 10 of the Health Service (Pharmaceutical) (Guernsey) Law, 1972, as amended^(a), hereby order:—

1. The prescription charge required to be paid by a person supplied with pharmaceutical benefit to an approved supplier under the provisions of section 10(1) of the Health Service (Pharmaceutical) (Guernsey) Law, 1972, as amended, shall be in the sum of seventy pence. Increase of prescription charge.

2. The Health Service (Pharmaceutical) (Prescription Charges) (Guernsey) Ordinance, 1983^(b), is hereby repealed. Repeal.

Extent. 3. This Ordinance shall have effect in the Islands of Guernsey, Herm and Jethou.

Citation. 4. This Ordinance may be cited as the Health Service (Pharmaceutical) (Prescription Charges) (Guernsey) Ordinance, 1984.

Commencement. 5. This Ordinance shall come into force on the 1st day of September, 1984.
