**The Indirect Taxes, Duties and Impôts
(Increase of Rates) (Amendment)
Ordinance, 1976**

THE STATES, in pursuance of their Resolution of the thirtieth day of September, nineteen hundred and seventy-six, and in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section one and section four of the Indirect Taxes, Duties and Impôts (Increase of Rates) (Guernsey) Law, 1970, as amended^(a), and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, hereby order:—

1. The First Schedule to the Indirect Taxes, Duties and Impôts (Increase of Rates) Ordinance, 1975 (hereinafter referred to as “the principal Ordinance”)^(b), is hereby amended as follows:—

Amendments to Ordinance of 1975.

- (a) in the first and second columns of Part I thereof the entries relating to paragraph 5 of that Part of that Schedule are repealed and the entries set out in the first and

second columns of the First Schedule to this Ordinance are respectively substituted therefor;

- (b) in the first and second columns of Part II thereof the entries relating to paragraphs 2 and 3 of that Part of that Schedule are repealed and the entries set out in the first and second columns of the Second Schedule to this Ordinance are respectively substituted therefor.

- Extent. 2. This Ordinance shall have effect in the Islands of Guernsey and Alderney.
- Citation. 3. This Ordinance may be cited as the Indirect Taxes, Duties and Impôts (Increase of Rates) (Amendment) Ordinance, 1976.
- Collective title. 4. This Ordinance and the principal Ordinance may be cited together as the Indirect Taxes, Duties and Impôts (Increase of Rates) Ordinances, 1975 and 1976.
- Commencement. 5. This Ordinance shall come into force on the first day of November, nineteen hundred and seventy-six.
