## **The Island Traffic Committee (Transfer of Functions) (No. 2) Ordinance, 1992**

**THE STATES**, in pursuance of their Resolutions of 12<sup>th</sup> March, 1987<sup>a</sup> and 29<sup>th</sup> July, 1992<sup>b</sup>, and in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by the Public Functions (Transfer and Performance) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Law, 1991<sup>c</sup> and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, hereby order: –

### **Transfer of functions of Island Traffic Committee.**

1. The functions of the Island Traffic Committee under the enactments specified in Schedule 1 hereto are transferred to the States Traffic Committee.

*In accordance with the provisions of the Machinery of Government (Transfer of Functions) (Guernsey) Ordinance, 2003, section 2, Schedule 1, paragraph 29, with effect from 6th May, 2004, the States Traffic Committee has since been replaced by the Environment Department; and the functions, rights and liabilities of the Traffic Committee and of its President arising under or by virtue of this Ordinance have been transferred to and vested in, respectively, the Environment Department and its Minister by the Machinery of Government (Transfer of Functions) (Guernsey) Ordinance, 2003, section 1, Schedule 1, paragraph 29, with effect from that same date, subject to the savings and transitional provisions in section 4 of the 2003 Ordinance. In accordance with the provisions of the Organisation of States' Affairs (Transfer of Functions) Ordinance, 2016, section 2, Schedule 1, paragraph 4(a), with effect from 1st May, 2016, the Environment Department has since been replaced by the Committee for the Environment & Infrastructure; and the functions, rights and liabilities of the Environment Department and of its Minister or Deputy Minister arising under or by virtue of this Ordinance were transferred to and vested in, respectively, the Committee for the*

*Environment & Infrastructure and its President or Vice-President by the Organisation of States' Affairs (Transfer of Functions) Ordinance, 2016, section 1, Schedule 1, paragraph 4(a), with effect from 1st May, 2016, subject to the savings and transitional provisions in section 3 of the 2016 Ordinance.*

**Savings.**

2. Anything done before the date of commencement of this section by or in relation to the Island Traffic Committee or any other Committee or person previously having exercised the functions herein transferred, and anything in the process of being done on that date, shall have effect as if done, or (as the case may be) may be continued, by or in relation to the States Traffic Committee.

**Transfer of functions of Board of Administration etc.**

3. (1) The functions of the States Board of Administration and States Supervisor under the Law entitled "Loi Supplémentaire relative aux Automobiles (Autorisations à Conduire), 1939"<sup>d</sup> and under the Motor Vehicles (Taxation and Licensing) (Tractors) Law, 1957<sup>e</sup> are transferred to the States Traffic Committee.

(2) The functions of the Inspector or Deputy Inspector of Police under section 10(b) of the Law entitled "Loi Supplémentaire relative aux Automobiles (Autorisations à Conduire), 1939" are transferred to the States Traffic Committee.

(3) Anything done before the commencement of this section by the Island Traffic Committee or its President and purported to have been done under any of the enactments specified in subsections (1) or (2) shall be deemed to have been lawfully done.

8. (1) The provisions of sections 1 (including Schedule 1), 2, 6 and 7 of this Ordinance shall be deemed to have commenced on 29<sup>th</sup> July, 1992.

(2) The remaining provisions of this Ordinance shall commence on the date when this Ordinance is made.

Section 4

**11.** In section 1(1) of the Road Traffic (Parking Places) Ordinance, 1963, for "States Island Traffic Committee" substitute "States Traffic Committee or such other Committee as the States may by Resolution prescribe".

wherever it occurs substitute the expression "the Committee",
